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New Aesthetic Proclaimed

Principality Receives Rainbow Makeover For 7

PA – Her Majesty, the First Princess has issued a new royal pronouncement declaring "Vibralume" to be the official art style of the year 7, for use by the government in a variety of contexts. Chosen by the First Princess and refined with the help of AI, Vibralume marked by its exaggerated environments, neon rainbow colors, and high contrasts. "We wanted something both futuristic and optimistic," said Her Majesty in a comment to *The Fortressian Letter*, "in these uncertain times people shouldn't be wallowing in fear. If we can add just a little bit of brightness to their day with Vibralume then we've made the right choice."

The previous year's official art style, Royal Impasto Verve, could not be more different than its replacement, with its heavily textured brush strokes and impressionistic yet reasonable depictions of daily life. Will each new aesthetic be in some sense the 'opposite' of the one that came before? It is perhaps too early to tell, this being the tradition's second year, but the willingness to make such a bold change signals Her Majesty's seriousness about entrenching the official aesthetic as a feature of the Fortressian government graphic design; no style is off the table.

Vibralume has not been met with universal praise, however, with many criticisms coming in as soon as it was announced. "It looks sort of generic," said one Pillowan, "and what happened to the unique colors schemes for the different departments?" A particular point of contention is how 'AI' the representative images appear to be. "With the previous look it was hard to tell it was AI," said a Pillowan speaking on condition of anonymity, "but with this new one it's hella obvious. Was this even a modern model? It looks like Dall-E 2." The government has never denied using generative artificial intelligence in any area of its graphic design. "Maybe the Princess just thinks it's cool?"

Regardless of whether or not Vibralume is destined to be one of the more enduring official aesthetics, it's here with us for the next nine months. Maybe Pillowans will be more successful using it than the government has been.

Constitutional Amendments Delayed

"The public facing image of the Principality is important," said a DoC spox, "and we recognize the Pillow Fortress Wiki is one of the first places Pillowans and others go to be informed. Keeping it in proper shape is an important form of public relations. We had prioritized content, but now that we have more time, we were able to go back and clean things up."

Frankly, this whole situation seems absurd. If other rumors are to be believed regarding just how long these amendments have been in the works, the First Princess could have easily promulgated them in Outwork 6 instead. Yet they're not so easily dismissed, with the source having provided accurate information on the inner workings of the government in the past. Original 'Pillow Fortress' Found

Magic: The Gathering Decklist Sheds Light On Late Prehistory
